#### **DISABILITY**




- Over 8700 people in East Herts have some degree of physical disability
- Around 3200 people have a Learning Disability
- Nearly 1400 people have dementia

'Disabled people are five times less likely to be employed than non-disabled people'

## **CARERS**

 Around 9% of people in East Herts have informal caring responsibilities

## **RELIGION AND BELIEF**



- 63% of East Herts residents classify themselves as Christian
- 1% residents follow Islam
