This is formal notice pursuant to Regulation 11 of the 2012 Regulations that a decision on the following matter will be made by officers:-

FRAMEWORK AWARD TO MEET THE NEEDS OF PEOPLE ON THE WAITING LIST FOR SUPPORTED LIVING

Reasons

The decision relates to a Framework award to meet the needs of people on the waiting list for Supported Living (a service which provides adults with disabilities with the support they need to remain living independently) There is a risk of service disruption if the Framework Award isn't made by mid-July resulting in a delay in the Service being able to find and confirm placements. It is also likely to cause issues for the Council's provider market which is ready to deliver services and the new Framework and contracting arrangements are part of the Council's work to make these services more sustainable.

As such, the decision on this matter must be taken by such a date that it is impracticable to comply with Regulation 10 of the 2012 Regulations.

In accordance with the Regulations and the County Council's Constitution, the consent of the Chairman of the Council's Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been obtained and the relevant Opposition Spokesmen have been consulted on the matter about which the decision is to be made.
