#### 1. Decision

To agree the statutory proposal to increase the number of places at Breakspeare School, a community special school and enlarge the premises of Meadow Wood School, a community special school, taking into consideration the outcome of the statutory notice period. The proposal will support an increase of 8 places at Breakspeare School from 9<sup>th</sup> April 2018. Breakspeare School is a school for pupils aged 3 to 19, with severe and complex learning difficulties. Meadow Wood School is a school for pupils aged 3 to 11, with physical and/or neurological impairments.

#### Reasons for the decision.

At the Hertfordshire County Council Cabinet meeting of 13<sup>th</sup> November 2017, Cabinet authorised the Director of Children's Services to publish a statutory notice to Increase the number of places at Breakspeare School and enlarge the premises of Meadow Wood School, to support an increase of 8 places at Breakspeare School from 9<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

The statutory notice period ended on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2017 and no objections to the proposal were received. It is now for the Director of Children's Services, under the terms of the delegated powers invested in her, to approve the proposal.
