### Location

The location where the new improvements will be delivered is at Codicote Road Roundabout, Codicote Road and Lower Luton Road. The roundabout is located to the north of Wheathampstead.

Neighbouring streets are:

- Station Road
- Lamer Lane
- Rose Lane
- Kingfisher Close
- Abbot John Mews
- Waddling Lane

St Albans High School is located on the north-east side of Codicote Road Roundabout, between Codicote Road and Lamer Lane.

Codicote Road is the main route to Welwyn Garden City. Lower Luton Road is the main route to Harpenden and Luton.

### Improvements

The improvements being delivered by Hertfordshire County Council are:

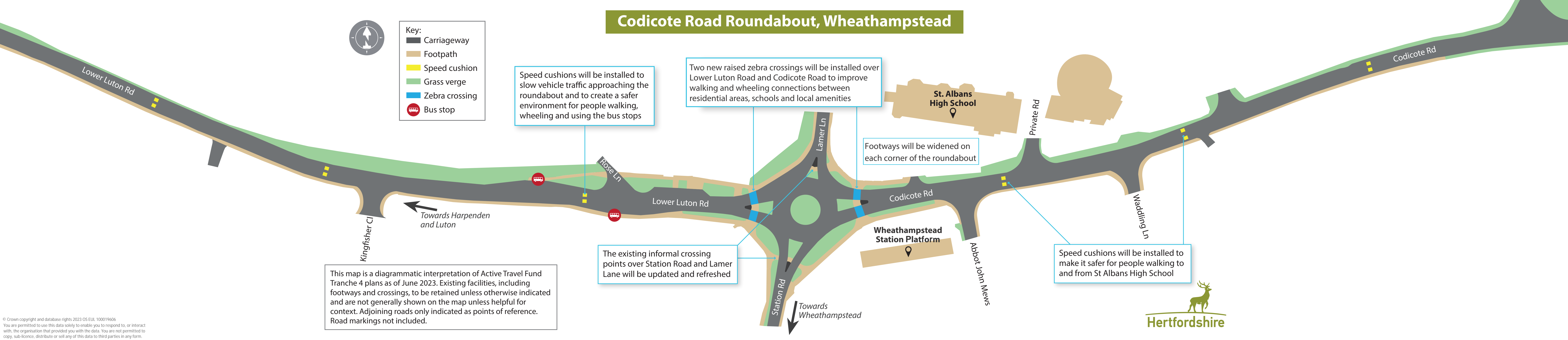
1. Two new raised zebra crossings will be installed over Lower Luton Road and Codicote Road at the west and east entry and exit points of the roundabout. These will improve walking and wheeling connections between residential areas, schools and local amenities.
2. Footways will be widened on each corner of the roundabout.
3. The existing informal crossing points over Station Road and Lamer Lane at the north and south entry and exit points of the roundabout will be updated and refreshed.
4. Speed cushions will be installed on Lower Luton Road and Codicote Road to slow vehicle traffic approaching the roundabout. Six sets of speed cushions will be installed, three on each side of the roundabout in the following locations:
  - a. On Codicote Road, just west of the junction with Cory-Wright Way
  - b. On Codicote Road, just east of Waddling Lane
  - c. On Codicote Road, near St Albans High School, just east of Abbot John Mews
  - d. On Lower Luton Road, just west of Rose Lane
  - e. On Lower Luton Road, just west of Kingfisher Close
  - f. On Lower Luton Road, further west of Kingfisher Close

Speed cushions will be installed to slow vehicle traffic approaching the roundabout and to create a safer environment for people walking, wheeling and using the bus stops

Two new raised zebra crossings will be installed over Lower Luton Road and Codicote Road to improve walking and wheeling connections between residential areas, schools and local amenities

Footways will be widened on each corner of the roundabout

The existing informal crossing points over Station Road and Lamer Lane will be updated and refreshed

Speed cushions will be installed to make it safer for people walking to and from St Albans High School
