Hertfordshire County Council Permit Scheme Evaluation Data - Year 3







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Hertfordshire have now been operating a permit scheme for 3 years.

I am pleased that Hertfordshire has continued to work together with the unitary authorities of Southend-on-Sea, Luton and Bedford to bring consistency to the common scheme which is the East of England Permit Scheme, EEPS. It is also good to see new schemes continuing to come into effect using some of the best practice developed through EEPS. A key success factor with the scheme has been the continued engagement with stakeholders to obtain real views and opinions as to how the permit scheme operation can continue to be improved.

It is good to see that we have built on our successes from the first and second years of operation of the permit scheme in Hertfordshire. We have done all the things we said we would do in the first two annual reports, and we continue to improve.

This report provides data from year 3 of operation of Hertfordshire's Permit Scheme. As reported in the second annual report we can demonstrate numbers of permits processed at all stages, and how efficient we have been, there still seems to be a national struggle to demonstrate and place a figure on how effective a permit scheme is. Through case studies, publicity and general messages from Hertfordshire's highway users we have also demonstrated that 'management of road works' is getting better. I'm hopeful that future measures which we are in the process of developing, will help to show that effective operation and delivery of a permit scheme in Hertfordshire delivers significant benefits to the local economy, helps in the fight against pollution and minimises congestion as much as possible, allowing the highway network to do its job in the safe movement of people and goods. We will add further performance measures as these develop.

During the changes to the scheme to bring in the Order to vary the scheme we have carried out two additional tasks, one to satisfy regulation 16A to consider the fee structure and the costs and benefits of operating the scheme, and the other to amend Hertfordshire's Traffic Sensitive Streets, the first review of these since 1991. The permit scheme continues to be 'cost neutral' for Hertfordshire, and we will continue to monitor this and develop incentives and discounts.
