

Hertfordshire County Council

Proposal to enlarge the premises of Greenside School, Shephall Green, Stevenage, Hertfordshire, SG2 9XS and increase by 16 places the number of places at the school from 1 September 2020

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Greenside School, a community special school, Shephall Green, Stevenage, Hertfordshire, SG2 9XS, with effect from 1 September 2020.

Hertfordshire County Council proposes to enlarge the premises of Greenside School, a school for pupils aged 2 to 19, with severe and complex learning difficulties. Hertfordshire County Council also proposes to increase the capacity at the School by 16 places from 1 September 2020.

The current capacity of the school is 140 and with the proposed enlargement the capacity will rise to 156 places. The current number of pupils at the school is 149 (School Census Autumn 2019). No new or additional site is required to enact this proposal.
