Proposal to enlarge the premises of Haywood Grove School to support an increase of 8 places at the school from 9 April 2018

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Haywood Grove School, a community special school, St. Agnells Lane, Hemel Hempstead, HP2 7BG, with effect from 9 April 2018.

Hertfordshire County Council proposes to enlarge the premises of Haywood Grove School, a primary special school catering for children aged 4 – 11 years with Social Emotional and Mental Health Needs (SEMH). The proposal will support an increase of 8 places at the school from 9 April 2018.

The current number of places is 40 and with the proposed increase the capacity will rise to 48 places. The current number of pupils at the school is 38 (School Census Spring 2017). No new or additional site is required to enact this proposal.
