

Hertfordshire County Council

Proposal to enlarge the premises of Woodfield School, Malmes Croft, Hemel Hempstead HP3 8RL and increase by 32 places the number of places at the school from 1 September 2020

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Woodfield School, a community special school, Malmes Croft, Hemel Hempstead HP3 8RL, with effect from 1 September 2020.

Hertfordshire County Council proposes to enlarge the premises of Woodfield School, a school for pupils aged 3 to 19, with severe and complex learning difficulties. Hertfordshire County Council also proposes to increase the capacity at the School by 32 places from 1 September 2020.

The current capacity of the school 88 and with the proposed enlargement this will rise to 120 places. The current number of pupils at the school is 104 (School Census Autumn 2019). No new or additional site is required to enact this proposal.
